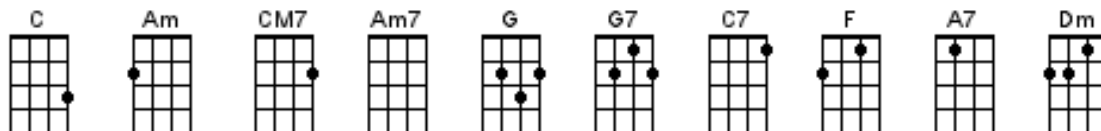


WALK RIGHT BACK [C] (Sonny Curtis – 1961 / The Everley Brothers)



INTRO: C - Am - Cmaj7 - Cmaj7 - Am7 - Cmaj7 - Am7 (x 4) [C riff]

I [C] want you to tell me why you walked out on me

[C] I'm so lonesome every [G7] day [G7 riff]**

[G] I want you to know that since you walked out on me

[G7] Nothing seems to be the same old [C] way [C riff]

[C] Think about the love that burns within my heart for you

The good [C7] times we had before you went aw- [F] ay, [A7] oh [Dm] me

[Dm] ↓ Walk ↓ right ↓ back to ↓ me ↓ this ↓ minute

[C] Bring your love to me, don't send it

[G] I'm so lonesome every [C] day [C riff] x2

These [C] eyes of mine that gave you loving glances once before

[C] Changed to shades of cloudy [G] grey [G7 riff]**

[G] I want so very much to see you just like before

I [G7] gotta know you're comin' back to [C] stay [C riff]

[C] Please believe me when I say it's great to hear from you

But there's a [C7] lot of things a letter just can't [F] say, [A7] oh [Dm] me

[Dm] ↓ Walk ↓ right ↓ back to ↓ me ↓ this ↓ minute

[C] Bring your love to me, don't send it

[G] I'm so lonesome every [C] day [C riff]
